



# Digital Adaptive SAT

## What is Adaptive Testing? How does it work?

An **adaptive test** calibrates to the student's skill level to **zero in on a score** more quickly. On the digital SAT and PSAT, each section is split into **two modules**. How you do on the first set of questions determines the **difficulty level** of your next module.

### FORMAT

32 MINUTES	Reading & Writing Module 1 (mixed difficulty)
32 MINUTES	Reading & Writing Module 2 (higher or lower)
10 MINUTES	Break
35 MINUTES	Math Module 1 (mixed difficulty)
